What does SUCCESS® Lending, LLC do with your personal information?

### Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information.

Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social security number and credit history
- Employment information and income
- Mortgage rates and payments and transaction history

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share our information as described in this notice.

### How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons SUCCESS® Lending, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing

## What we do

**How does SUCCESS® Lending, LLC protect my personal information?** To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

**How does SUCCESS® Lending, LLC collect my personal information?** We collect your personal information, for example, when you;

- Apply for a loan or give us your employment history
- Give us your income information or provide your mortgage information
- Show us your government-issues ID

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

## Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes
  - information about your creditworthiness
- Affiliates from using your information to market to you
- Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

## Definitions

**Affiliates** Companies by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non financial companies.  
*Our affiliates include financial companies such as TRIMAVIN, LLC*

**Nonaffiliates** Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  
*SUCCESS® Lending, LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you*

**Joint marketing** A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  
*SUCCESS® Lending, LLC doesn't jointly market*

## Other important information

California: in accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of success lending, llc unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extend required by California law.
